




Heated Multideck Instruction manual

Safety Tips

- Position on a flat, stable surface.
- A service agent/qualified technician should carry out installation and any repairs if required. Do not remove any components on this product.
- Consult Local and National Standards to comply with the following:

 - BS EN Codes of Practice
 - Fire Precautions
 - IEE Wiring Regulations
 - Building Regulations
- **Warning! Hot surface! Always wear safety gloves when placing or removing foods.**
- This product is only designed to store food temporarily. Do not use for laboratory or industrial purposes.
- DO NOT use jet/pressure washers to clean the appliance.
- DO NOT use the appliance outside.
- DO NOT use the appliance to store medical supplies.
- DO NOT use electrical appliances inside the appliance (e.g. heaters, ice-cream makers, etc.).
- DO NOT allow oil or fat to come into contact with the plastic components. Clean immediately if contact occurs.
- DO NOT store products on top of the appliance.
- Always carry, store and handle the appliance in a vertical position and move by holding the base of the appliance.
- Always switch off and disconnect the power supply to the unit before cleaning.
- Keep all packaging away from children. Dispose of the packaging in accordance to the regulations of local authorities.



- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a BUFFALO agent or a recommended qualified technician in order to avoid a hazard.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience or knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

Introduction

Please take a few moments to carefully read through this manual. Correct maintenance and operation of this machine will provide the best possible performance from your BUFFALO product.

Pack Contents

The following is included:

- Buffalo Heated Multideck
- Instruction manual

Should you find any damage as a result of transit, please contact your BUFFALO dealer immediately.

Installation

1. Remove the appliance from the packaging. Make sure that all protective plastic film and coatings are thoroughly removed from all surfaces.
2. Maintain a distance of 20cm (7 inches) between the unit and walls or other objects for ventilation.




Note: Before using the appliance for the first time, clean the shelves and interior with soapy water.

3. Set the brakes on the castors to keep the appliance in position.

Operation

Control panel

The control panel is located below the handle on the front of the appliance.



Turn On

1. Ensure the on/off switch is set to **O** and connect the appliance to a mains power supply.
2. Set the on/off switch to **I**.
3. Press the  button to turn the light On or Off as required.

Setting the Operating Temperature

1. Press the **SET** button. The previously set temperature is displayed.
2. Press the  or  button to display the required temperature (Range: 30°C - 80°C).
3. Press the **SET** button to store the temperature.



Note for the Heating Indicator: The LED will be on during heating up and off when the set temperature is reached and maintained constantly.

4. The appliance is now ready for food to be displayed and kept warm.

Using the Night Curtain

- If necessary, extend the plastic night curtain downward and hook it into place.



Cleaning, Care & Maintenance



Switch off and disconnect the appliance from the power supply. Allow to cool down before cleaning.

- Withdraw the door for ease of cleaning.
- Clean the interior of the appliance as often as possible.
- Use warm, soapy water and a damp cloth to clean the appliance.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents. These can leave harmful residues.
- Always wipe dry after cleaning.

Replacing the Interior Lamp

- Call your BUFFALO dealer or a qualified electrician. The Lamp Assembly is available to purchase as a spare part.

Troubleshooting

Fault	Probable Cause	Solution
The unit is not working	The unit is not switched on	Check the unit is plugged in correctly and switched on
	Plug and lead are damaged	Call BUFFALO agent or qualified Technician
	Fuse in the plug has blown	Replace the plug fuse
	Power supply	Check power supply
	Internal wiring fault	Call BUFFALO agent or qualified technician
Poor heating effect	Poor ventilation	Increase ventilation
	Door is opened frequently or not shut properly	Check door is hooked in place.
	Food too cold or too much food in the appliance	Remove excessive food
	Temperature improperly set	Re-set the temperature
Loud noises	The appliance has not been installed in a level or stable position	Check installation position and change if necessary
	The appliance is too close to a wall or other object	Move to a well-ventilated position.
Odour from the unit	Unit is not cleaned for long time	Clean the unit thoroughly
The lamp does not illuminate	Lamp needs replacing	Call BUFFALO agent or qualified technician
	Light not turned on	Ensure  button has been pressed properly

Electrical Wiring

This appliance is supplied with a 3 pin, moulded, BS1363 plug and lead, with a 13 amp fuse as standard.

The plug is to be connected to a suitable mains socket.

This appliance is wired as follows:

- Live wire (coloured brown) to terminal marked L
- Neutral wire (coloured blue) to terminal marked N
- Earth wire (coloured green/yellow) to terminal marked E

This appliance must be earthed.



If in doubt consult a qualified electrician.

Electrical isolation points must be kept clear of any obstructions. In the event of any emergency disconnection being required they must be readily accessible.


